School Council have also been tracking the work on the new sensory music garden.



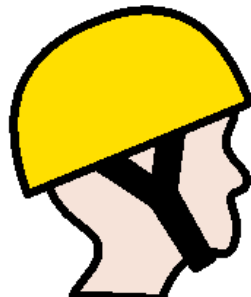
School Council were interested in the Magic Carpet and were the first to trial it.
